All applications received during the first month of each quarter will be processed within that quarter and the final disposition determined by the end of that quarter.

Deadlines for complete applications are January 31st, April 30th, July 31st, and October 31st. For those applications that arrive on or before the deadline, decisions will be made no later than March 31st, June 30th, September 30th, and December 31st, respectively.

The Polo Development Initiative Application must establish a clear mission with the following info:

- a. A list of proposed goals and overall objectives;
- b. A list of the products and/or services delivered;
- c. A detailed budget to justify the need for funding;
- d. A list of the project resources including employees (if any), a list of outsourcing references and the location of the program;
- e. A detailed timeline of your polo development project;
- f. A brief biography of the applicant's leadership references with special mention of any contribution to the sport of polo;
- g. Sponsoring Club or USPA Committee endorsement; If an application is sponsored by a Club, then the Club Delegate should be listed in the application as either an applicant or at least listed as a reference complete with contact information. USPA Committee endorsements in the application must include the Committee Chair as either an applicant or reference;
- h. A list of resources available to publicly promote this project if the funding is approved i.e. local newspaper, *Polo Players Edition* magazine, etc.;
- i. Any additional comments or supporting supplements;
- j. All PDI applicants must be a USPA Registered Player and all participants of PDI projects must be a USPA Registered player, Registered Associate or Registered Student membership classification.
